

### **Wat is the NVTAG prize**

The NVTAG prize is a prestigious award for a young promising researcher, who has contributed to the development of Health Technology Assessment (HTA) research methods in an original manner. The award selection is based on manuscripts published in the previous calendar year and on pitches by nominees of their research findings at a symposium by the Dutch Association for Health Technology Assessment (NVTAG).

### **Prizes**

On top of eternal fame and recognition, the winner will receive a cheque.

### **Conditions for submission**

- One manuscript submission per contestant
- The manuscript contributes to the development of Health Technology Assessment (HTA) research methods in an original manner and is published in the year 2023.
- The contestant is first author of the manuscript.
- The contestant is a member of (young-)NVTAG.
- The contestant is <36 years old or less than 5 years active in the field of HTA research
- The contestant will be able to attend the NVTAG prize award ceremony (11 April 2024) and is willing to pitch his/her work there.

### **Procedure**

An independent jury will shortlist 3 nominees from the submissions. The assessment is based on:

- Relevance of work to HTA developments
- Quality and accuracy of methods and research question
- Article set up: writing, figures, tables etc.

The top 3 nominees are invited to pitch their research at the NVTAG prize award ceremony (11 April 2024).

During the online award ceremony, the jury score is combined with a public vote determining the 2023 winner. In case of a draw, the jury vote is decisive.
